


The approach is developed by the term 'metamorphose' in variable ways, like; temporality, spatiality and experiences. The aim is expressing these terms which are integrating each other by transformation and metamorphosis. The ideas which are representing the 'metamorphose' are evaluated in some cases like; the individual participation on design and practice, the outcomes of this spatial and temporary experiences., using the 'concrete' as a tool for experiences by users, the natural and spontaneous process. The aim of temporary spatial product is investigated by deconstructing the whole process. So a festival experiment and collective work idea integrated to this project for emphasising the process. This project claims being an alternative production for integration between the spatial environment and it's users.



## Project Phases:

The area is choosed through the possibility for social activities and the chance of transformation for the neighbourhood. The project is planned to be also an **installation** of a landscape element itself and implement in anywhere. It is aimed to exist in the part of the city and experience by it's users who are also it's producers.

At the elementary phase; The places of the little hills are determined. Two level hole (total height is 100cm) is digged first. These two level holes are seperated by a material which is vanishing and integrating with nature easily. The first one (from the top) is thinner than the other material (theese seperators are stabilized due to bearing the system). And then the ground is filled by soil due to make little hills on the last seperator (180 cm height from the last seperator) These hills are planned to use as a tool for shaping the concretes. Then the process of wrapping hills by concrete canvas, is started. The hills are wrapped randomly and assembled to each other at the overlapped parts of concretes by the participants of the festival.

At the last phase the concrete is watered to make solidification of canvas concretes. These processes ends up with these concrete dots. And then the nature gives the final form to the ground by rain, wind and natural vanishing process at the bottom part of the hills. We are expecting; the first seperators will vanish in approximately two years. The seeds will grow up from the holes.



The metamorphose of the holes under the concretes will be a home for street animals or a game area for children in addition to being a landscape element. Concrete dots will be variable spatial and planted areas after these process.

The individuals, who are also a participant of this process, can watch over these metamorphose and they will have a chance to experience various spatial phases in years. Due to this festival and the metamorphose of the holes, 'concrete' will aslo have a power to transform spatial memories.
